Christine Ochoa from the Girl Scout Council Office spoke on varying topics:

**Website Calendar:** Remember to always check the website for different events. On April 23<sup>rd</sup>, there will be a "Keepers of the Earth" event. Also, all event flyers will now be emailed. She will be checking to see who we should notify at council if we want to put an event on the calendar.

**Background Checks:** Remember to make sure that everyone who is a leader of in charge of money needs to have a background check run.

**Treasurer's Report:** Jan reported that the service unit's current account balance is \$3,600.99.

**Registrar's Report:** Pam Hunt had no new news, but stated that whenever troops are registering for anything with the council the troop number should have 5 numbers in it. If your troop has less than that, add a zero to the beginning until you get 5 numbers. (Example: Troop 3231 would be 03231)

**Older Girl Surf Camp:** On Friday July 8<sup>th</sup> – Sunday July 10<sup>th</sup> there will be a “Camp Surf” for girls entering 7<sup>th</sup> grade or above. The cost is \$220 per person, which includes everything but lunch. The girls will learn how to surf while earning the “Fun in the Surf” IP. For more information, you can go to <http://www.camp.ymca.org/english/indexsurf.html>. There is a \$100 deposit due to reserve the spot because space is limited.

**Badge Days:** On April 17<sup>th</sup>, there will be a Veterinary Science Badge & IPA Day. It will be held at CV Park and the cost is \$10. There is still space for Brownies and Juniors. On May 15<sup>th</sup>, there will be a Speaking In Sign Badge Day. It will be at the Montrose Scout House. The cost is \$12. The older scouts will go in the morning, while the younger scouts will come in the afternoon and will be taught by the older scouts. This is a council event.

**Tasting Bee:** Kaila Toone reported that the Tasting Bee will be held on February 20, 2011, at Holy Redeemer. It is from 10 – 2 pm. There will be 12 troops participating. There will be a Silent Auction and an Opportunity Drawing. **The Silent Auction is the Service Unit's only fundraiser!!** Some of the prizes include an American Girl Doll, a pearl necklace and 4 Disneyland Park Hopper tickets. There will be tasting bee tickets, passport & a patch. The registration fee is \$8 per girl and you get a patch and 25 tasting tickets. For adults, guests, etc. there will be tickets on sale for 5 tickets for \$1. Please invite community members, friends and family as this is the service unit's only fundraiser!!!

**Badge Bonanza:** We will be holding another badge bonanza to sell extra badges. It will be at the service unit meeting on March 15<sup>th</sup>.

**Cookies:** Carol Fairshter spoke about the cookies. The cookies are scheduled for delivery on Saturday, February 19<sup>th</sup>. Stephanie Fram explained that the delivery time for each troop is in Greenbeans. She needs volunteers that are 9<sup>th</sup> grade and up to help out. The boothing scheduler is now open and will remain open until March 15<sup>th</sup>. Remember to show up on time, show up in uniform and DON'T LEAVE ANY TRASH (INCLUDES EMPTY BOXES). Carol reported that nationwide the initial orders are up 1½%, our service unit sales have increased by 5% with 76 troops selling, and council wide the sales are up 10% from last year. There are 1500 new girls selling council wide, and initial orders were almost 6900 boxes. The cupboards open on February 24<sup>th</sup>. The hours and information for each cupboard is listed in greenbeans. Remember to review the cupboards schedule before you order because they have different hours. Up until March 3<sup>rd</sup>, any cupboard orders have to be in full cases. You will order in boxes, but it has to be in multiples of 12 to make up a case. After March 3<sup>rd</sup>, you can order in individual boxes. The boothing kits are available for pickup when you get your cookies on February 19<sup>th</sup>. Also, council needs some assistance in staffing the Arcadia Cupboard. It would be Seniors & Ambassadors that are needed from February 24<sup>th</sup> through March 19<sup>th</sup>. Please contact Tamar or Judy Hubbs if you can be of assistance.

**Girl Scout Picture Day:** Picture Day will be held on 3/26/11 at Holy Redeemer Church. It will start at 9 am and finish at 1 pm. Susie Zadravec will be sending out an evite as well. Each girl should have their own order form. The pictures will be mailed four weeks after picture day.

**CPR Class:** There will be a CPR class in April 2011 held at the scout house. The trainer has previously trained girl scouts. It will be for older girls and parents if there is room. Parents and leaders will be the first to have a space. They will be confirming the age of the girls if they have space for more people. You can also check out St. Joseph's and Verdugo for first aid/CPR classes for the girls.

**Bridging Ceremony:** The bridging ceremony will be held on June 11<sup>th</sup> at Glenola Park. It will be from 12 – 2 pm. There will be a committee meeting on March 10<sup>th</sup> at the scout house starting at 6 pm for anyone who wants to help plan this ceremony. This bridging is for all levels of girl scouts.

**Arbor Day:** Lisa Dutton explained that they need a troop to represent the girl scouts on March 19<sup>th</sup> from 9 – 12 pm for Arbor Day. It will be at Two Strike Park and can be any level of scouts from Brownies and up. They would need to have a booth and the one requirement is the girls must be in uniform. You can't sell cookies unless you are donating all the proceeds to the service unit. 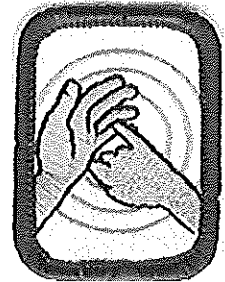
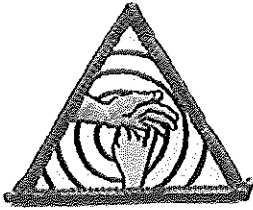
