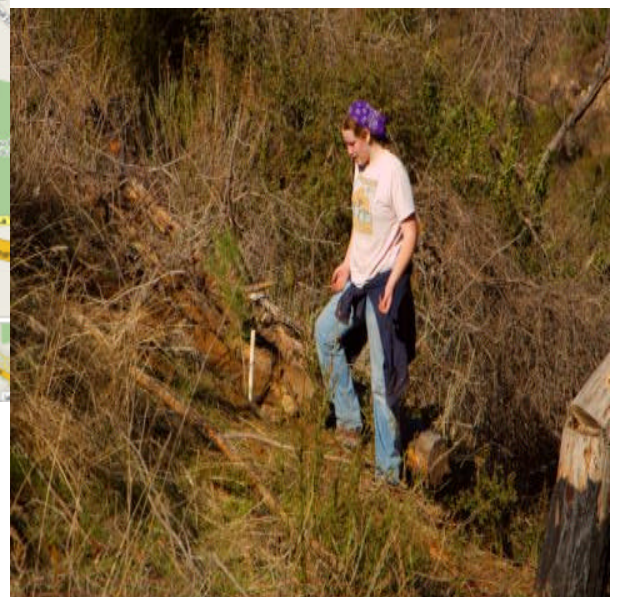
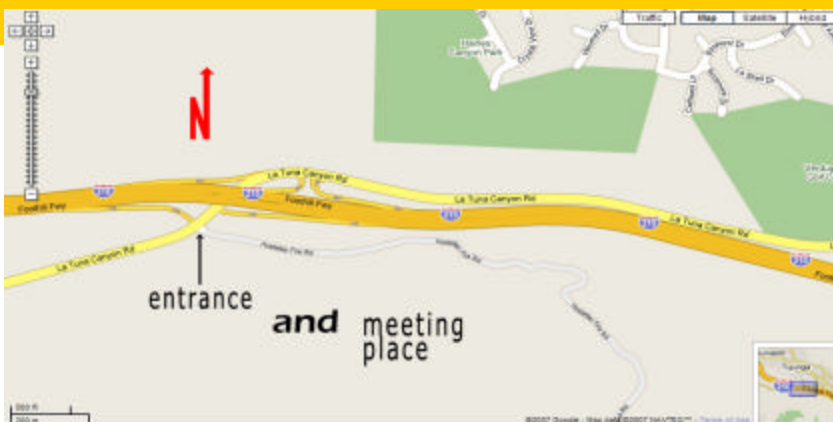
Gate closes at 9:15 a.m., so please be prompt. The event will conclude by 12:00 p.m. and the gate will be reopened at 12:15.
