Unit Leads (ULs) – For girls entering 10th grade and above. You must have Program Aide Core Training and have been a PA at Twilight Camp for at least two years. **You must attend the Program Aide Skills Day and Twilight Camp Training Day.**

All **PATs**, **PAs** and **ULs** will have the opportunity to earn the Forester IPA and the Dinosaur IPA with some work done at home.
