Who: Girls must be 7-12 years old (entering 2nd to 7th grade in September 2011); Camp is limited to the first 150 girls to register with complete registration packets (including a fully complete Health History Form). Any non-scout wishing to participate must register as a Girl Scout for an additional \$12.00 (due at time of camp registration).

Incomplete registrations will be added to a waiting list, applicants notified of missing items, and processed only once all requisite paperwork has been completed; girls on the waiting list will be accommodated on a space-available basis. Letters postmarked prior to April 1st will be returned.

Cost: \$80.00 per girl (plus \$12.00 Girl Scout registration if girl is not currently a girl scout). Fees cover the cost of T-shirt, crafts, Try-Its/Badges/Interest Project Awards, Camp Fun Patch, DVD of Camp Memories, 3 meals, & loads of fun.
