

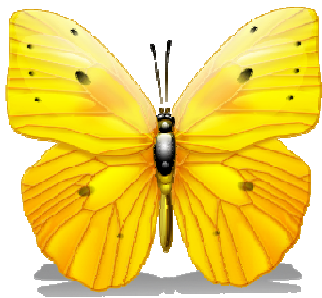
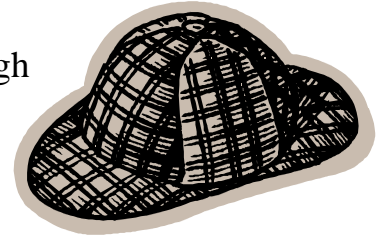


TWILIGHT CAMP 2010

Come to learn about deduction, problem solving, and detective skills through chemistry magic, a trail mystery, decoding secret messages, mystery prints, pictures and games. *Girl Scout Investigators* will have fun with brain teasers, science experiments, mystery games, crafts and more.



Put your detective skills to work learning about the natural environment around you! We will learn about insects in fun ways, such as through games, artwork, skits, and snacks. *Girl Scout Investigators* will learn about the body parts of insects, how to safely capture insects, study them and release them back to their environment, and learn to distinguish harmful from harmless insects. Girls will make their own bug glasses and antennae.

Who: Girls must be 7-12 years old (entering 2nd to 6th grade in September 2010); Camp is limited to the first 120 girls to register with complete registration packets (including a fully complete Health History Form).

Any non-scout wishing to participate must register as a Girl Scout for an additional \$12.00 (due at time of registration).
